

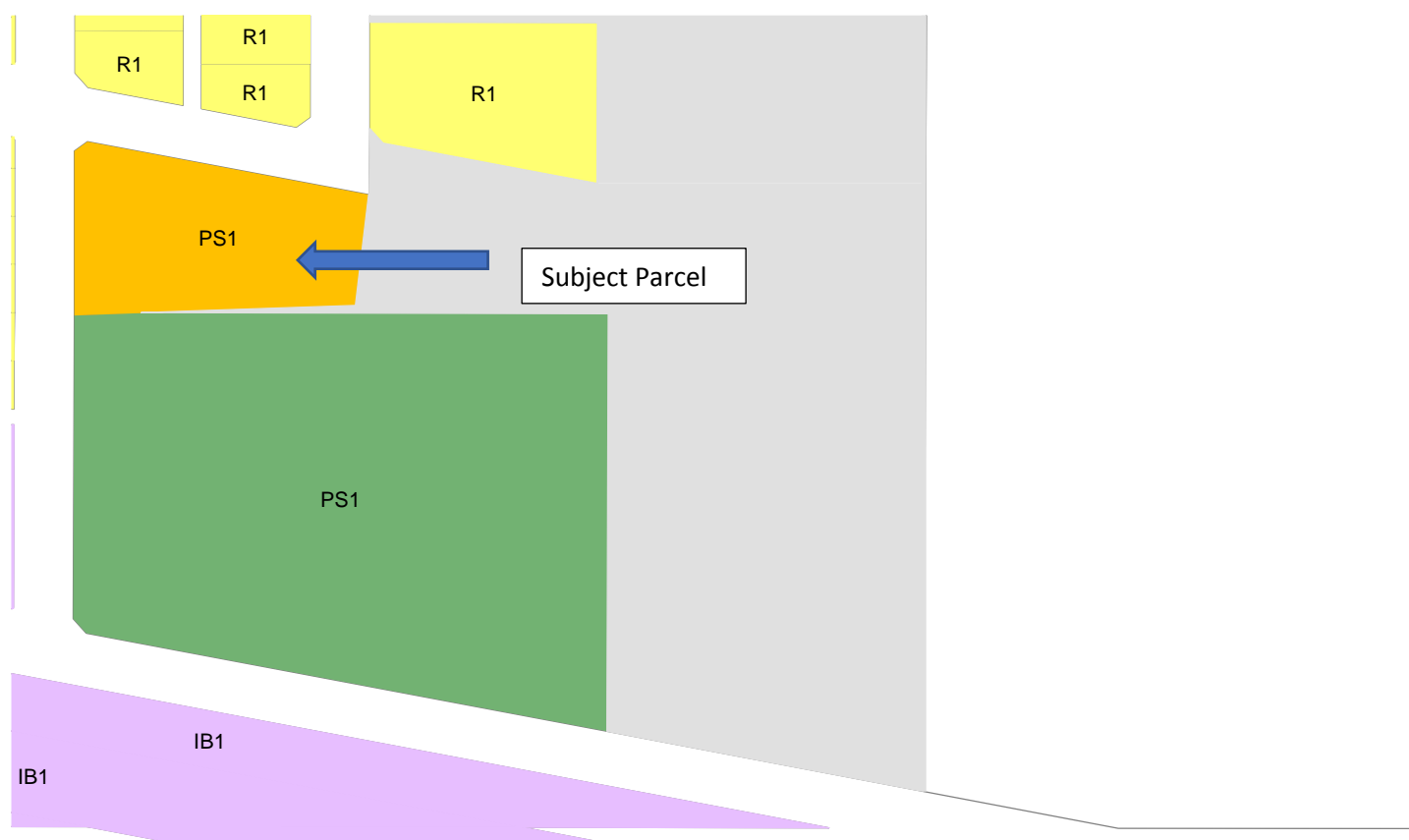
BYLAW 2018-820

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF MANNVILLE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL LAND USE BYLAW NO. 2006-734

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend the Land Use Bylaw 2006-734

The Council of the Village of Mannville in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to authority conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000 enacts as follows:

1. That the Land Use Bylaw no. 2006-734 and the Land Use District Map, attached to and forming part of the Land Use Bylaw of the Village of Mannville, be amended by redistricting Plan 9824726 Lot 1 from Public Service District (P-1) to Residential Low Density Multi-Dwelling District (R-3)



Parcels to be redistricted: Plan 9824726 Lot 1

Current Land Use: Public Service District (P-1)

Land Use Change to: Residential Low Density Multi-Dwelling District (R-3)

2. If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed, and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.

3. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the date of third reading and signing in accordance with Section 692, Municipal Government Act, Revised States of Alberta 2000.
